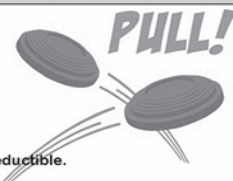

And any crafts to make it your design, scissors, (12) pipe cleaners in the color of your wreath design

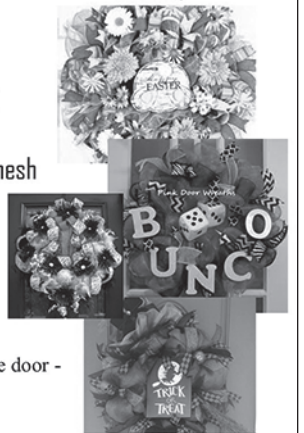

LEGION OF HONOR COLOR GUARD

There are reportedly over 209 million adults in this country. 8% of these are military veterans.

Shriners International reports approximately 350,000 Shriners in the world. If we use the same 8% ratio that would mean 28,000 active Shriners are military veterans. Considering the character of most Shriners it would be a reasonable assumption to state that there are probably many, many more military veterans in the Shrine than a mere 8%.

Alee Temple reports 1360 members. Applying the same 8% ratio would mean that Alee has 109 military veterans in our membership. Again, considering the character of most Shriners I have met in Alee, odds are there are probably a heck of a lot more military veterans in the Alee Shrine than a measly 8%.

The International Association Legions of Honor (IALOH) reports a Shrine membership of 9000, indicating only 2.57% of Shriners are Legion of Honor members. If we apply this percentage factor to Alee, this means 34 Alee Shriners are members of the Alee Legion of Honor, but we actually have far less than that.

If you are a veteran of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marines, or currently serving on active duty, we want you as a member of Alee Legion of Honor. We want you to help us foster a spirit of patriotism and love of our country and flag. We want you to help continue a tradition that is nearly 100 years old, by being a valued member of the Legion of Honor and by showing a representation of the honorable services and sacrifices of our veterans.

Greenville has received a total of 38,662 gifts with a year to date total of \$5,485,468.00 being donated to the hospital. Of the \$8,018,345 million donated. \$2,232,040 was given by the 18 Shrine Temples/Clubs/Units supporting Greenville.

Our Donor Development continues to work with each Temples Transportation Coordinator and Recorder to ensure our Road Runners are in compliant with the Hospitals System's requirement that all transportation volunteers be Covid Vaccinated. If you have not sent a copy of your vaccine card, please get a copy to Lady Colleen at the temple office at your earliest convenience. Our Greenville Hospital continues to operate with restrictions in place for all entering the hospital. This is being done to insure our patients and staff stay well while in the building. Our hospital works hard to provide a safe and secure building for all who visit. The Board of Directors continue to meet virtually at least through June.

As of December, Alee Shrine Temple referred 57 patients who will benefit from the excellent services of Greenville. Please keep up the hard work locating and referring those children who can benefit from the excellent medical care offered by the Doctors and Staff of Greenville.

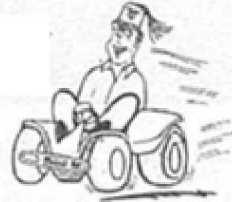
