

# Masonic Youth

I would like to challenge the Nobles of the Oasis of Alee to invest in the traditional sponsored Masonic Youth the future of our Craft, the Shrine and our Nation.

All the DeMolay Chapters and Rainbow Assemblies are active and working within the Oasis of Alee. This does not mean they do not need support from the Nobles and Ladies of Alee. Just as our Masonic Lodges and other affiliated Bodies need new members, so do our DeMolay Chapters and Rainbow Assemblies.

To answer a question that some have asked, and some have not. Just as a Lodge, Shrine Unit, Club and Temple are not a one- or two-person operation. Neither is a DeMolay Chapter, or a Rainbow Assembly are a one- or two-person operation. Just as our Masonic Organizations have officers and Members DeMolay Chapters and Rainbow Assemblies have their officers, and members. DeMolay Chapters and Rainbow Assemblies also have adult volunteers called Advisors that play a very vital role in their organization and success. Even with this, it is still not a one- or two-person operation.

Both of these Youth organizations are required to have these adult volunteers called Advisors as part of their organization. Without these Advisors, neither of these youth organizations can meet, or have any events. The Majority of these Advisors are made up of Masons, which includes Shriners, Members of the Order of Eastern Star, Order of Amaranth and Senior DeMolays or Majority Rainbows. Neither of these Youth Organizations just accept anybody to be an advisor. The qualifications and requirements are different between the two Youth Organizations and would take more room than I have available in this article to explain.

Most of our Masonic Brethren only see either the Chapter Dad for the DeMolay's and the Mother Advisor for the Rainbows at functions. Simply because these are the primary advisors who interact directly with the Youth. Both the DeMolay Chapters Advisory Council and the Rainbow Advisory Board have their own established officer line. Both have a Chairman, Secretary-Treasurer in addition to the Chapter Dad and the Mother Advisor. Since most of us only see the Chapter Dad or the Mother Advisor, the perception many have is that it takes only one or two advisors to operate a Chapter or an Assembly. That would be nice, but it is not a luxury a Chapter or an Assembly can afford.

In my humble opinion, over and beyond the need of new members our DeMolay Chapters and Rainbow Assemblies. They need something from our Masonic Fraternity that is more valuable than money. You ask what is more valuable than money? The answer to that question is TIME! Both organizations require your valuable time. Both organizations need members of the Masonic Fraternity to become advisors or ambassadors to their Masonic Affiliated Bodies and encourage and push for more support to these traditionally masonic sponsored Youth Organizations, Georgia DeMolay and Georgia Rainbow. Maybe you cannot give up your time to be an active participating Advisor, but you can speak out in support of these organizations at your Masonic Lodge, Scottish & York Rite, Shrine Temple, Club and Unit, OES and Amaranth meeting. You can encourage these Masonic Bodies invite these Youth Organizations to present a program at their respective Meetings or help at a Dinner, or a fund raiser. May be even instead of writing a check for a donation to them. Invite them to be a part of a fund raiser, at the same time show them how to do a fund raiser and share in the profits.

§ 325.11 Election Regulations.

(a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish, and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating, or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email, or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers' void and order a new election.

(d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.







# Oriental Guide....Must be Selected Wisely

When the members of a Shrine Temple elect a Noble to the office of Oriental Guide they are virtually starting that Noble through the Divan line on the assumption that he will prove qualified for and worthy of advancement to the high of Illustrious Potentate.

Hence it is quite evident that the nomination for Oriental Guide should be based upon thorough and accurate evaluation of character, ability, prestige, interest, and experience.

A Noble can be a good fellow, a hard worker and a loyal Shriner...and yet lack the basic qualifications which make a good Potentate. Unless a Noble is fully qualified for the job he is unfair both to himself and his Temple in seeking the office or in permitting his fellow Nobles to support and promote his candidacy.

Each Shrine Temple needs and requires able quality leadership. The normal starting point of that leadership is the office of Oriental Guide. The following checklist may prove helpful in evaluating potential candidates for the office of Oriental Guide. However, no thinking man would be naïve or presumptuous as to believe that any one Noble could possibly embody all of the virtues talents and qualifications which are set forth in this checklist. Nevertheless the list has a practical value...for self-evaluation by the Noble whose ultimate aspiration is the office of Illustrious Potentate. and for the advance evaluation of potential candidates by the voting members.

1. He should have good business judgment.
2. He should have the ability to express himself clearly in language that will make us proud of him rather apologetic.
3. He should present an imposing personal appearance.
4. He should be able to hold his own and advance the interest of his Temple and Freemasonry in high places as well as among the humble.
5. He should be devoted Mason and constantly promote the interest of Freemasonry in high places as well as among the humble.
6. He should be proud yet humble.
7. He should have good character and a past open to investigation.
8. He should be a leader have good standing in his community and be influential in its affairs.
9. He should be financially secure.
10. He should be in good health, full of energy and vitality.
11. He should be able to devote ample time to his Shrine duties.
12. He should be a man who when he appears anywhere in public you will be proud of not apologetic for his short coming.
13. His wife should be able to understand his devotion to duty; realize that he will become a Potentate and not she; be able to dress and wear appropriate clothing and be familiar with social amenities. Remember she is destined to become First Lady.

Nominations for Oriental Guide should be based upon thorough and accurate evaluation of character, ability and interest. Remember you are electing your spokesman and standard bearer, the one who will represent you and your Temple. We have great talent in our Temple. Let us seek out the best man we can find who is willing to make the sacrifice. And it requires great sacrifice! Many Temples have suffered from inferior Potentates because of hasty judgment and oversight of qualifications when selecting Oriental Guides.

## Pediatric Colorectal Center Helps Patient Gain Independence and Confidence

Shriners Children's Northern California Colorectal & Gastrointestinal (GI) Inpatient Bowel Management

Bowel management is a subject that most 14-year-old boys can't have a serious conversation about. But Mathew, a 14-year-old pediatric colorectal patient at Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California, has the vocabulary to talk about his colorectal condition with poise and confidence. Mathew has been a Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California pediatric colorectal center patient since he was 10, and he willingly shares his story with kids and parents who might benefit from it.

Mathew's mother, Tiffany, first noticed something different about Mathew when he was 2. He was having trouble potty training. His bowel movements were infrequent and unpredictable. The family, who lives in a rural community outside of Reno, Nevada, sought care from a nearby gastroenterologist. The next seven years would be filled with physical and emotional hardship for Mathew. Mathew's care routine required that he drink large volumes of liquid medicine and sports drinks to flush his bowels every four days. The routine was time consuming and uncomfortable. Tiffany noticed Mathew's mental health was suffering. He couldn't participate in school activities and trips, and sleepovers were out of the question.

When Mathew was 9, Tiffany decided to seek a second opinion. She hoped for a better life for her son, and visited a few different doctors before turning to Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California. At the Northern California Shriners Hospital, Mathew's team would be led by Payam Saadai, M.D., a pediatric surgeon who specializes in pediatric colorectal disorders.

"Dr. Saadai is amazing," said Mathew. "He's a friend. And this may sound strange, but Shriners [Hospital] is like a second home to me."

Dr. Saadai and the Shriners Hospitals for Children care team — which included social workers, child life specialists, nurses, dieticians and physicians — evaluated Mathew. Mathew and his parents were then presented with various treatment options.

"It was really a collaborative process," said Tiffany. "The whole team of experts sat down together to discuss Mathew's case, and then they presented different options to us. They included us in the treatment decision and welcomed our questions and concerns."

Mathew would undergo surgery to repair his large intestine, which had suffered damage over the years. After lots of deliberation, Mathew and his parents decided on an ACE Malone that would enable him to flush his bowels through his belly button. This option meant Mathew would no longer need to drink large volumes of medicine and fluids to flush his system. It would also save him from needing a colostomy bag, so he would be able to swim and do other physical activities without worries.

"Our care team was really amazing," said Tiffany. "The doctors gave so much thought to Mathew's different treatment options, so that he could live like any other kid. The doctors and nursing staff did so much to educate us about how to care for Mathew once we were home."

Today, Mathew's quality of life is greatly improved. He sees his Shriners Hospitals for Children doctors twice per year. He can participate in school trips, sleep over at friends' houses, and can do pretty much anything other kids his age can do. He trains in karate, plays video games with his friends and loves to swim.

Tiffany credits Dr. Saadai and the Shriners Hospitals for Children — Northern California team for Mathew's quality of life today.

"His quality of life today is so much better than it would have been if we never found Shriners," said Tiffany. "He is doing so much better emotionally and mentally. He's now this confident kid, willing to share his medical journey with others who might benefit from his story. I credit the Shriners team, the Shriners family, for giving him that confidence."

## Wrap-Around Care: Shriners Children's Avoids the Risks of Superficial Treatment Part 1

Fausaga had plenty of reason to be upset. The 17-year-old Samoan's biggest passion, playing football, was over — at least for the foreseeable future — as he awaited revision knee surgery on his ACL (anterior cruciate ligament) tear.

But, luckily for Fausaga, the staff at Shriners Children's Hawai'i didn't see him (or anyone else, for that matter) as just another name on a long list of patients. The pediatric healthcare system's philosophy of wrap-around care considers every aspect of a child to treat their mind, body and soul in a way that's tailor-made for them.

"We treat the whole patient," said Helene Freni-Rogers, recreational therapy manager at Shriners Children's Hawaii. "It takes into consideration their physical, social, cultural and emotional well-being. It means making sure that all of our patients' needs are met."

Kerry Marini, M.Ed, CTC, coordinator of education and transition at Shriners Children's Northern California, agreed that this approach is vital. "To completely heal from a traumatic injury, all aspects of treatment are equally important as medical care."

Our care takes into consideration their physical, social, cultural and emotional well-being. It means making sure that all of our patients' needs are met. Helene Freni-Rogers, recreational therapy manager, Shriners Children's Hawaii

Just as every patient who walks through the doors of a Shriners Children's facility is different, so, too, is their wrap-around care — defined as any ancillary care received in addition to strictly medical treatment. That includes everything from traditional care (pharmacy, nutritional services, physical therapy and occupational therapy) to newer approaches (music therapy, pet therapy and aquatic therapy) to special programs (makeup clinics for burn patients, cooking classes and peer support). Birthdays and holidays are celebrated with gusto, and facilities across the country even have location-specific activities, such as surfing in Hawaii.

Since there are so many types of wrap-around care available, the choices can be overwhelming. Luckily, providers have a tool that can point them in the right direction, said Krystal Vermillion, MOT, OTR/L, a staff therapist at Shriners Children's Greenville. Motion analysis studies can help determine if the potential gains of a therapy are worth the negative aspects, such as potential pain, travel, time off work for parents, stress, etc. This truly tailors the care to each and every patient.

This patient-centered combination of disciplines creates a loving and supportive environment designed to help each child thrive and develop the Shriners Children's characteristics of CARE: Confidence, Ambition, Resilience and Empathy. These qualities are exemplified by Shriners Children's five AmazeKids.

"Successful wrap-around care helps a child cope better with their hospitalization, surgery and rehab," Freni-Rogers said. "Their moods can be more stable, and they can feel more in control of their situation. In general, our aim in recreation therapy is to make our patients happy. Happy hearts lead to better coping and healing."

Marini noted that patients heal more rapidly and completely when feeling and acting optimistically. "Positive behavior will enhance proper treatment, rehabilitation and recovery," she said, leading to higher confidence as well as better coping, social and emotional expression skills.

Even just recognizing that a patient has needs beyond the purely physical can be beneficial. "When we are intentional in our efforts to acknowledge and address the psychosocial needs of children in our care, we see improvements in their overall mood, affect, confidence, self-efficacy and pain," Vermillion said. "Even if we cannot fully address all of their concerns or needs while they are here, acknowledgment goes a long way in building trust and translates into increased compliance with recommendations and better outcomes overall."


