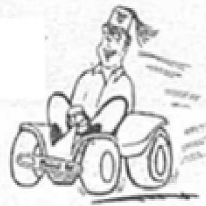

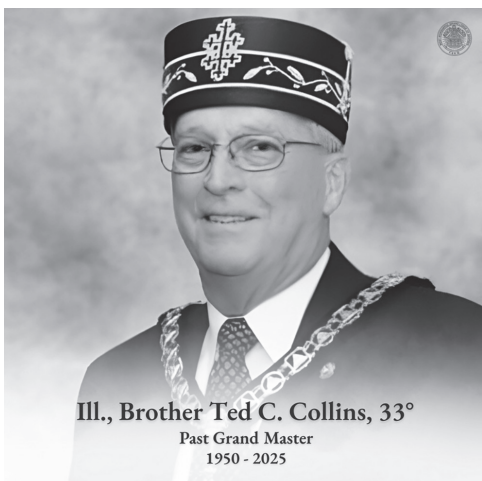
He laid down his working tools on October 17, 2025.

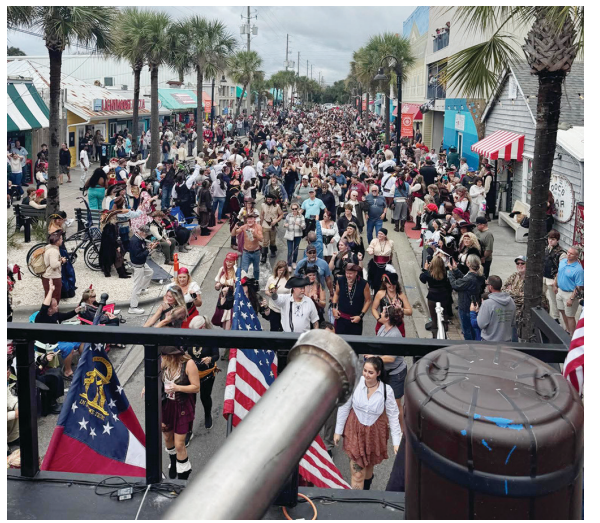

Freddie L. Humphries Jr, the 2025 Fall Ceremonial Honoree

It was a hot summer day in July of 1963 when Freddie Humphries was born to Lyndal and Fred Humphries. The eldest of five children, Freddie quickly showed his natural leadership skills and work ethic, often guiding his siblings and friends — a quality that would define much of his life. Of course, it came off as telling them what to do, but you get the picture.

Freddie graduated from Savannah High School and later from Savannah Vo-Tech. In 1990, he earned his Electrical License for the State of Georgia. He went on to build a career as an Industrial and Commercial Electrician, a profession he has proudly served in for over 40 years.

In August of 1991, Freddie married the love of his life and steadfast supporter, Colleen Rovolis. Also known as the Temple Secretary. Together, they built a strong and loving family, raising two daughters, Holly and Mary — both of whom have always been his biggest cheerleaders. Together, they form what he fondly calls **Team Humphries**.

Freddie's Masonic journey began in the Spring of 2001 when he was initiated, passed, and raised at Richard T. Turner Lodge. That same year, he became a Master of the Royal Secret in the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite. He was created a Noble of the Alee Shriners (AANOMS), with Illustrious Sir C.S. Kaney serving as Potentate. He joined the Dune Cats Unit in December 2001, later serving as President in 2005 and again in 2017 — a testament to his commitment and leadership. Under his guidance, the Dune Cats earned recognition as Unit of the Year in 2005. He is currently on track to serve again in 2026. Freddie is also a member of Tybee Lite Shrine Club.

In 2007, Freddie was honored with the Knight Commander of the Court of Honour (KCCH) designation in the Scottish Rite. Two years later, in 2009, he served as Worshipful Master of Coastal Daylight Lodge. In 2009, he also joined Alee's Knights of Mecca, where he proudly served as President in 2018.

Throughout his Masonic career, Freddie has served in numerous leadership and support roles:

- Personal Aide in 2006 and 2008
- Chief Aide in 2007 and 2025 (for Illustrious Sir Danny Fries Jr.)
- Chief of Staff from 2015 to 2017

Since 2006, he has chaired the Haunted House Construction and Maintenance Crew, a project close to his heart. Perhaps most notably, Freddie has served as Chair or Co-Chair of the Alee Temple Building and Grounds Committee from 2002 to the present. Under his leadership, the committee has undertaken many improvements — most notably, upgrading lighting in the ballroom and installing energy-efficient LED lights around the property, saving the Temple over \$9,000 annually since 2018.

Today, Freddie continues his service and leadership as **Vice President of SASA** and is slated to serve as **President** for the 2026–2027 term, if elected.

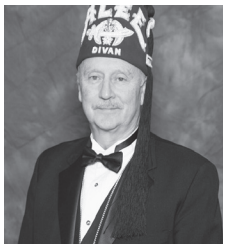

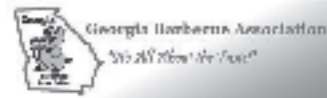

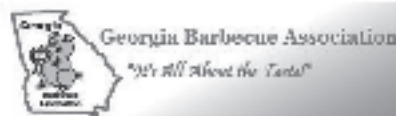

Shriners Children's Erie patient Abigail and her orthotist, Hannah Clark, MS, CPO, traveled to Orlando, Florida, where they received prestigious national recognition from the American Orthotic and Prosthetic Association (AOPA) at its National Assembly.

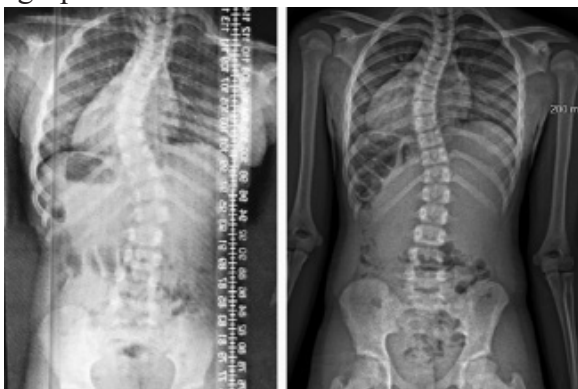
On September 4, the pair served as keynote speakers, sharing their story with an audience of more than 500 attendees. "It was pretty scary, I was really nervous, but I was so happy when Hannah joined me on stage to help tell my story," Abigail said.

For the past four years, Clark has treated Abigail's scoliosis, working closely with the Shriners Children's Erie Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services team and Spinal Technology to design a custom anterior open Boston 3D brace specifically for her. Abigail's physician, Stephen Mendelson, M.D., recognized that her severe double major curve, including a high thoracic curve, required a unique approach. He requested a brace that was both low profile and highly effective. Unlike traditional braces, the Boston-3D applies corrective pressure on the outer side of the curve while cutting out corresponding areas on the inner side, allowing the spine to shift in the desired direction. Thanks to Abigail's dedication to wearing the brace and the customized design, her scoliosis curve has been reduced by more than 50%, an outcome that is rarely achieved.

Coincidentally, just days before Clark learned of AOPA's prompt, Abigail had jokingly remarked that she deserved an award for her dedication to wearing her brace. And she truly did, so Clark knew exactly who to nominate. Abigail's journey perfectly illustrated the prompt: The symbiotic relationship between manufacturers, clinicians and patients — leading to successful fits and outcomes — is often overlooked unless it involves a high-profile case.

Within days, they found out they had been chosen. Soon after, Abigail and Clark were invited to Orlando to share their journey on the national stage. The trip also brought another milestone for Abigail and her family. It was their very first time flying on an airplane, adding to the excitement and memories of this once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Their story demonstrates the power of collaboration among patients, providers and industry partners to achieve life-changing results. By celebrating Abigail's perseverance and Clark's dedication, this national recognition not only highlights the impact of personalized scoliosis care, but also underscores the role of Shriners Children's Erie in advancing pediatric specialty care locally and across the country.

To never turn a child away.

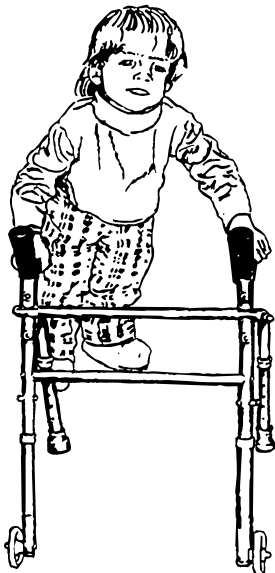
I could not bear to see their tears,

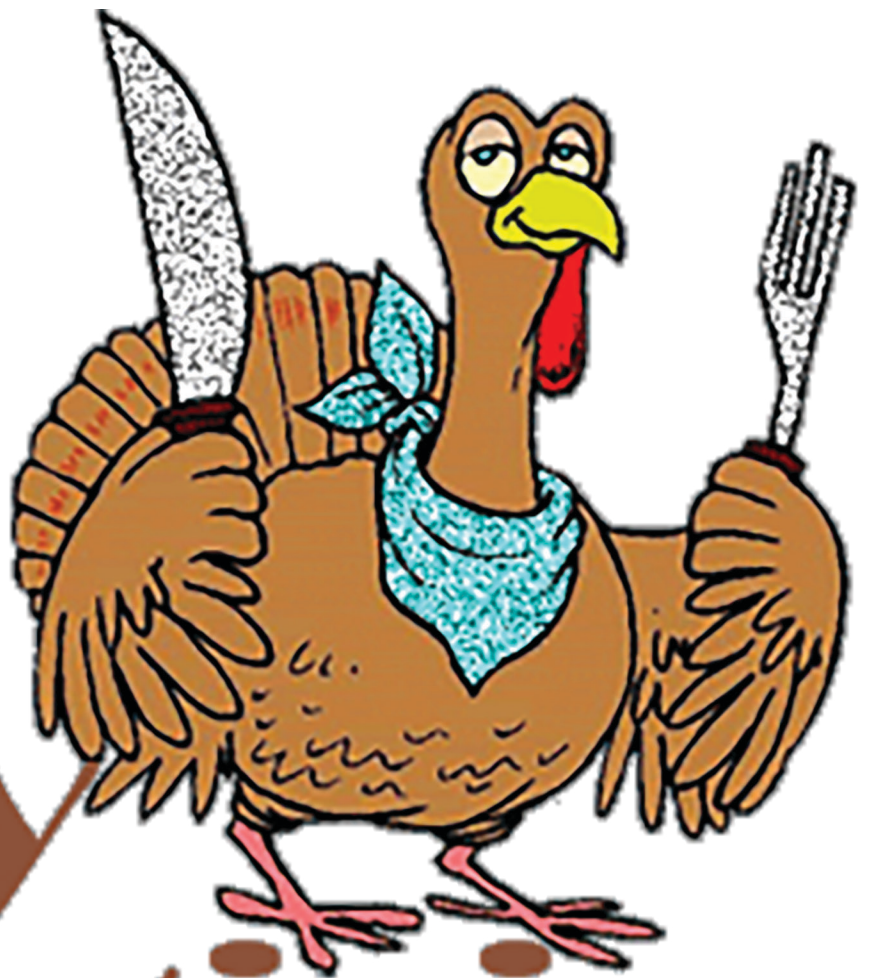
