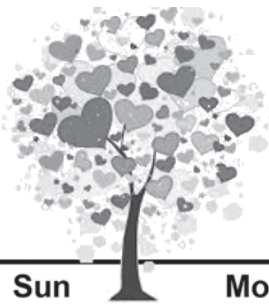

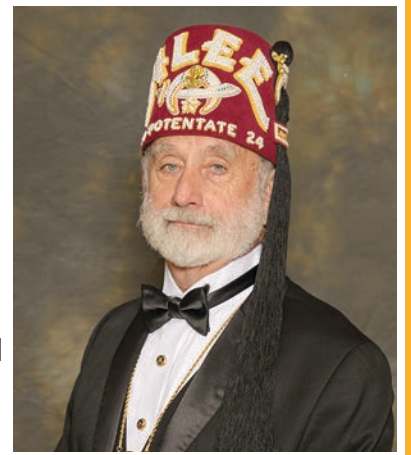

FEBRUARY BIRTHDAYS

Appointments Are for Only One Year

When a Potentate's term of office expires, all appointments made by him during his administration **terminate** according to the Imperial Code. Such appointments include all appointed officers, Potentate's aides, members of committees and their chairman, special appointees, directors, assistant directors, and all members of the Potentate's staff.

Some uninformed nobles have mistakenly believed or assumed their appointments to be permanent; that is not! Each Potentate when installed in office must make his own appointments including divan appointments.

The Potentate has the power and authority, under Imperial Shrine law, to replace every appointee, or he may, if he believes it to be in the best interest of the Shrine, retain all appointees by reappointment.

Traditionally, for the sake of efficiency, many nobles of demonstrated ability are continued in office or appointment by reappointment. But this is at the will and pleasure of the incoming Potentate.

In no case is he bound, or can he be bound by his predecessor. By the same token in no case can any Potentate bind his successor.

If it is the will and pleasure of the incoming Potentate that the noble is to continue in his office or position by reappointment, he will be notified by the Potentate to that effect.

Should any noble not holding appointment by the current Potentate wear a fez carrying any title such as "Aide" or any other designation, he does so in violation of the code.

Some nobles seek to perpetuate an appointment fictitiously by adding to the lettering on the fez the year or years of their appointment. This is a violation of Imperial law. The offending may be informed but "... ignorance of the law is no excuse."

Henry's Forever Smile

Henry's [Shriners Children's Boston](#) story started before he was born. His mother, Meghann, had an anatomy scan when she was 20 weeks pregnant, revealing her son's diagnosis: a [cleft lip](#) and [cleft palate](#).

"I met with a doctor and she recommended Shriners Children's Boston for cleft lip and palate care," said Meghann. The condition, typically diagnosed during an ultrasound, gives doctors a head start in mapping out a care plan.

Facial clefts form in the womb and are the No. 1 craniofacial birth difference treated at Shriners Children's. A cleft lip forms when the lip does not properly develop, causing a newborn's smile to split. A cleft palate is the result of tissues on the roof of a child's mouth not fusing. If the conditions are not fixed, they can affect breathing, speaking, eating and appearance. "Very early in a child's development, these segments don't meet up properly and that leads up to these fissures and clefts that we know of as cleft lip and palate," explained [Jay Austen, M.D.](#), a [plastic surgeon](#) on the cleft and [craniofacial](#) team at Shriners Children's Boston and chief of plastic and [reconstructive surgery](#) at MassGeneral Brigham. The Shriners Children's Boston Cleft and Craniofacial Center is a collaborative program with MassGeneral Hospital for Children.

Patients will receive a comprehensive care plan to meet their clinical and developmental needs. In a single visit, patients have access to [plastic surgeons](#), [speech pathologists](#), orthodontists and dietitians. "You may only need one of us, you may need five of us, you'll need us at different points in your child's life, but you know that's what we're here for," said Dr. Austen.

In June 2022, when he was just 4 months old, Henry had his cleft lip repaired, followed by surgery to address his cleft palate the following November. We were all stressed out about the upcoming surgery and the recovery. Dr. Austen made it seem like everything would be okay.

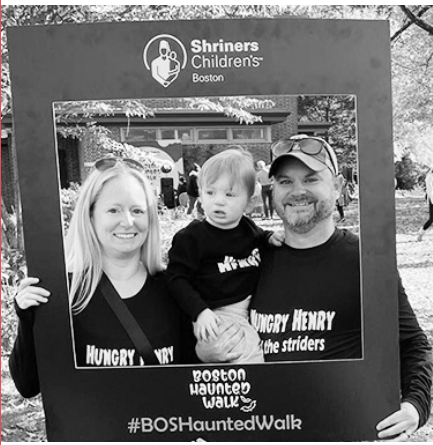
Meghann credits Dr. Austen with helping her family prepare for Henry's hospital stays. "We were all stressed out about the upcoming surgery and the recovery. Dr. Austen made it seem like everything would be okay," she noted. "That was helpful to have his perspective of 'this is something the hospital has done for a long time, and this is not something to be afraid of or worry about.'" Meghann said Dr. Austen's optimism and positivity helped the family throughout the treatment process.

Patients in the cleft and craniofacial program benefit from clinicians who routinely treat cleft lip and palate conditions. "That's one of the many great things about the Shriners cleft lip and palate program. We have a world-class team dedicated to not only doing this work, but doing it together to make it not just the best care, but the easiest care for the families," said Dr. Austen.

Meghann shared that the clinical team, especially Sandy Barrett, a nurse care manager, was a great resource. Nurse [care managers](#) and [social workers](#) are available during and in between appointments, to support patients and their caregivers with the answers to questions associated with craniofacial conditions. "Sandy, who has helped us with coordinating appointments, has been helpful. Anytime I email her a question, she is so responsive."

Henry is a happy and active toddler who loves playing with airplanes and trucks. "We call him 'Wreck-It Ralph,' he's like a bull in a china shop, he loves to have fun," joked Meghann. Henry also loves listening to music, especially with his grandfather. "My dad will watch music videos with him. Every time he hears music, he's drawn to it."



Meghann gets emotional when describing how important the Shriners Children's Boston [music therapists](#) were to her son. "I remember the first time he had his lip done, they had a woman playing guitar," said Meghann. "She was singing *Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star*." Pediatric-trained music therapists tailor each session to fit the child's needs. The sessions can help provide comfort during a procedure, act as a distraction to help with pain management, or improve a child's sleeping patterns. Music therapists work directly with a child's care team to understand their individual goals and monitor progress.

Meghann urges young families who have received a similar diagnosis to take advantage of early intervention and other resources provided at Shriners Children's Boston. "We have a speech therapist who works with Henry. In the beginning, it was help with feeding with the cleft palate, which was challenging," Meghann explained. "Once he had the palate repair, just making sure he was able to feed, then transition from formula to solids."

Even though the process has been challenging, Meghann explained that it is manageable. "From the start to finish, it has been great working with the team at Shriners Children's Boston. We've always felt like the team is helpful and accommodating. They have the best interests of Henry in mind."

Reno Teen Up and Running Thanks to Scoliosis Care at Shriners Children's

From the time Jackson was very young, his mother, Shannon, had an instinct telling her something wasn't quite right.

"I distinctly remember looking at him when he was around one thinking, 'his back doesn't look quite right,'" said Shannon.

It was a good thing she listened to her instincts, because before Jackson reached his first birthday, doctors had diagnosed him with [congenital scoliosis](#) – an abnormal curvature of the spine that affects newborns and young infants. The curvature causes the spinal column to bend left or right in the shape of an S or C. When he was 13 months old, Jackson was in a full [back brace](#). Based on her own research, however, Shannon knew the brace was not going to improve his outcome completely.

Struggling to Find Care

Shannon took her son to a few doctors throughout the Reno, Nevada, area and struggled to find a doctor who specialized in pediatric [spine](#) and scoliosis care. "It was devastating," she said. "You're already overwhelmed as a new mom, and not being able to find someone that specialized in Jackson's condition was so frustrating."

At the time, Shannon worked at a local country club and struck up a conversation with a gentleman who believed he could help. He encouraged Shannon to reach out to [Shriners Children's Northern California](#), knowing that the facility had an excellent pediatric spine program – one of the best in the nation.

As soon as Shannon stepped foot inside Shriners Children's Northern California, she knew she was in the right place. "That man changed our lives," she said. "We were able to get in quickly and the staff was amazing. They remembered our names at follow-up appointments, and they were genuinely interested in how I was doing – taking in all of this information regarding Jackson's diagnosis. They cared about Jackson and they cared about me as his mother."

The Best Care

After speaking with a number of doctors and pediatricians in and around Reno, desperately trying to find help for Jackson, Shannon felt how different the environment was at Shriners Children's. She could immediately feel the difference that being in a hospital that is specifically tailored to providing care for children makes.

"Doctor's offices have a tendency to be kind of stale, but the combination of having staff who know how to relate and communicate with children, an activity pavilion for kids to run around and play in, and knowledgeable staff just always made us feel like we were in the right place receiving the best care possible for Jackson," said Shannon. "And he never cried. Whenever we went to see his team at Shriners Children's, he never, ever cried."

Jackson underwent two surgical procedures to treat his scoliosis – one at the age of 5 and again at age 13. Chief of Orthopedics [Rolando Roberto, M.D.](#), performed the surgeries. Now, Jackson is a competitive cross country star, running many miles each week – something his mother never imagined he'd be able to do.

"I'm so proud of how far he's come," said Shannon. "This place saved my son, and I want everyone to see all the wonderful opportunities Jackson has because of the care he's received at Shriners Children's."

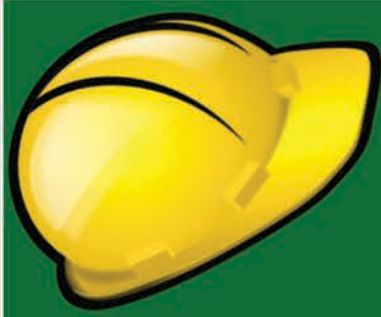

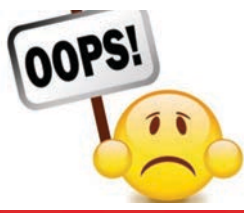
