Noble James Oscar “Jim” Hood – 2026 Summer Ceremonial Honoree

James Oscar “Jim” Hood was born on July 1, 1948. November 18, 1967, he married Linda Haynes, and together they raised two daughters, Lori Murrell and Cheryl Armstrong.

Jim joined the United States Army in 1966 and proudly served as a member of the Army Reserves until 1985. Before beginning a long and dedicated career with Interact of Savannah, Inc. in 1983, he worked as an over-the-road truck driver. He later retired from Interact of Savannah after years of faithful service.

Jim’s Masonic Journey began in 1984 when he joined Frank F. Baker Lodge No. 46 in Garden City, Georgia. He became a Perpetual Member of the Grand Lodge of Georgia in 2018. During his years of service to the Lodge, he served as Worshipful Master in 2003, Lodge Secretary from 2003 until 2008, and District Deputy beginning in 2008, serving as Chairman until 2012.

He is also a member of Alee Shriners and the Hillbilly Unit, where he served as President of the unit in 2003.

Jim joined the Scottish Rite in Savannah, Georgia, in 1992. Over the years, he has held numerous positions of leadership and honor within the organization. He was elected Master of the Lodge of Perfection in 2003, invested as Knight Commander of the Court of Honor (KCCH) in 1999, and received the prestigious 33° Inspector General Honorary in 2007. From 1998 until 2018, he served as Manager of the Stage Crew. In 1998, he was elected to the Board of Trustees of the Scottish Rite Valley of Savannah, where he faithfully served until 2022.

In 2019, Jim was elected as a Trustee of the Masonic Home and continues to serve on the Board.

His York Rite and appendant body involvement is extensive. In 2018, he was elected to Herman E. Freeman York Rite College No. 186 and remains active in the officers’ line. On July 16, 2016, he was invested in The Order of Saint Patrick. He is also a member of the Commemorative Order of St. Thomas of Acon, Oglethorpe Chapel No. 21, where he serves in the officers’ line.

Jim is active in the Grand Council of Allied Masonic Degrees of the United States of America and serves in the officers’ line. He is also affiliated with Savannah Council No. 326 and ~~Kneeknockers~~ Swamp No. 494.

Within the York Rite bodies, Jim is a member of Grand Council of Georgia No. 2, Grand Chapter of Georgia No. 3, and Palestine Commandery No. 7 in Savannah, Georgia. In 2018, he served as Past Thrice Illustrious Master, Past High Priest, and Commander of Palestine Commandery No. 7.

He became a member of the Tall Cedars of Lebanon in 2010. In 2020, he joined Crowned Martyrs Council No. 120 and continues serving in the officers’ line. Since 1992, he has also been a member of the Scottish Rite Research Society.

Jim is a member of the Oglethorpe Conclave of the Red Cross of Constantine and serves in the officers line.

In 2021–2022, Jim served as the 1st Masonic District Master. In recognition of his dedication and leadership, he received the J. Walter Cowart First Masonic District Mason of the Year Award in 2023. In 2025, he served as Counsel for the Defense in the Trial Commission of the 1st Masonic District.

Additionally, Jim is a member of the National Sojourners of America, having served twice as President and as Commander of the Hussar Chapter of Georgia.

Through decades of service, leadership, and dedication to Freemasonry and his community, Jim Hood has built a legacy of commitment, brotherhood, and honor.

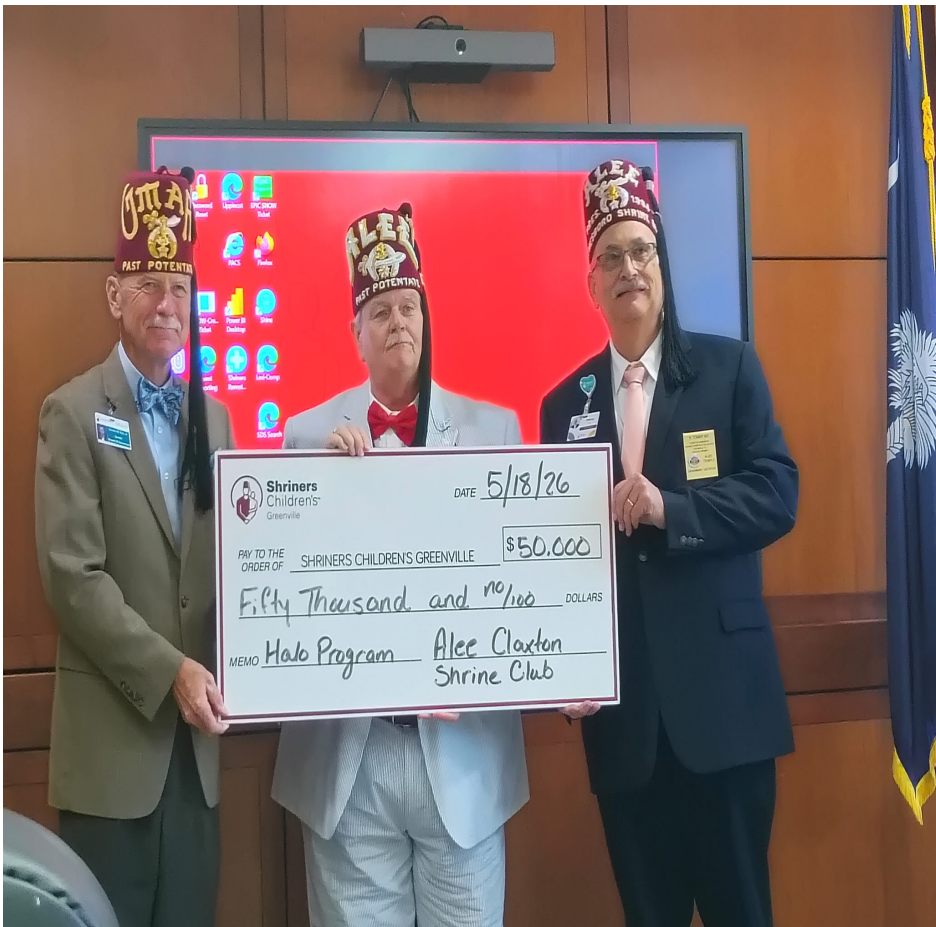

It is a reflection of hearts committed not just to themselves, but to lifting others up.

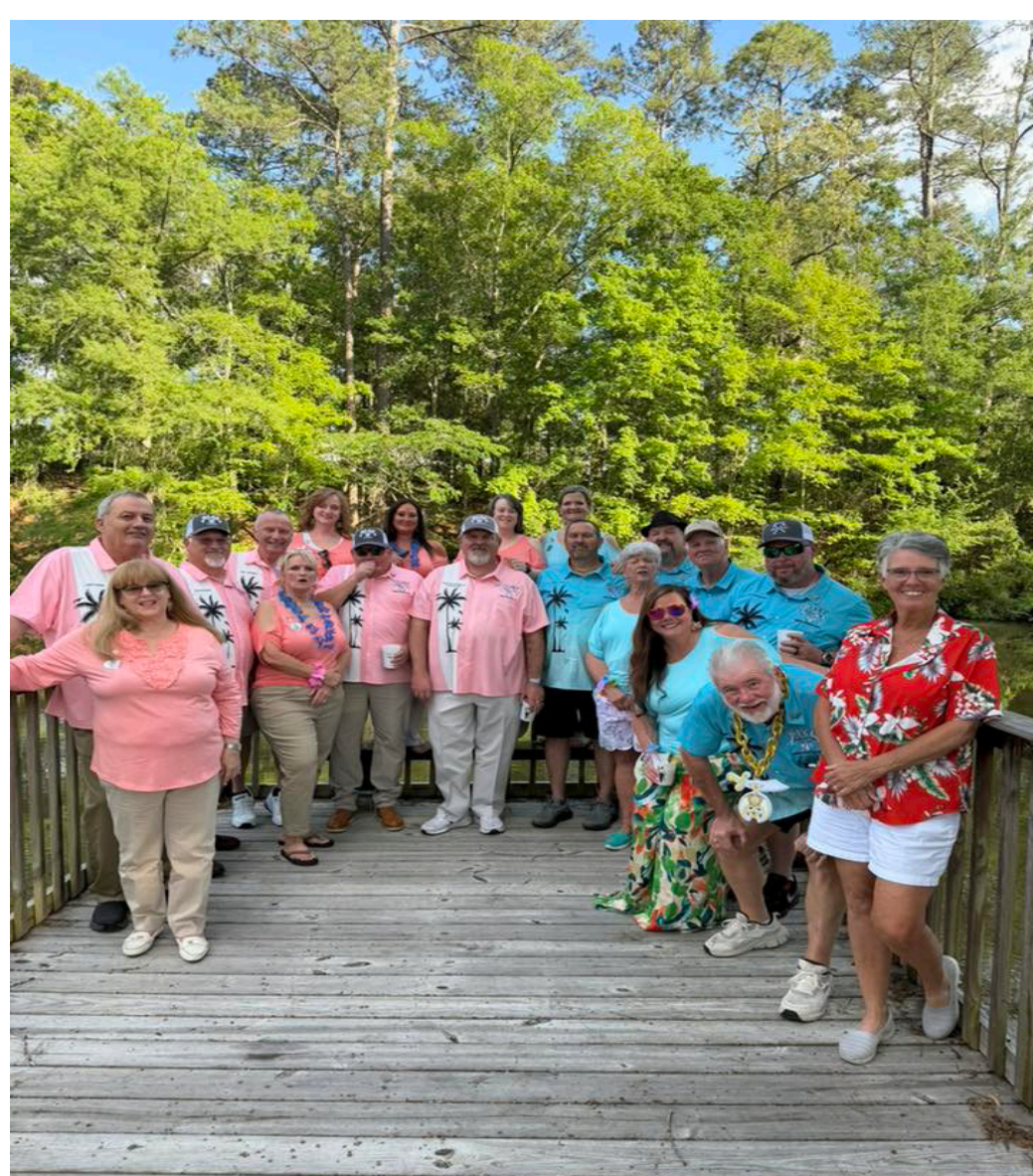

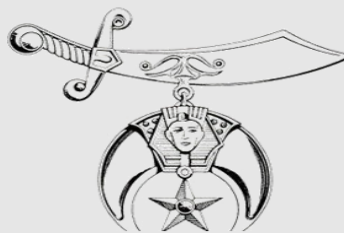

Shriners Children's News

Marley is an ambitious sixth-grader from New Caney, Texas, with a talent for a little bit of everything.

She dances in ballet and jazz styles, plays volleyball and basketball for her school, and enjoys singing. She performs in community theatre and has recently spent her Saturdays rehearsing for Moana. The 12-year-old is even enrolled in advanced math, working on problems a whole grade level ahead. Marley keeps a full schedule and enjoys every minute of it. So when she began experiencing ankle pain, it needed immediate attention.

In January 2026, Marley visited the chiropractor near her school. Although her initial visit was for her ankle, Marley's back had been bothering her as well, so she mentioned it during the appointment. The chiropractor scanned her spine and noticed a curve that needed closer inspection. They encouraged Marley and her family to visit Shriners Children's Texas for pediatric orthopedic care.

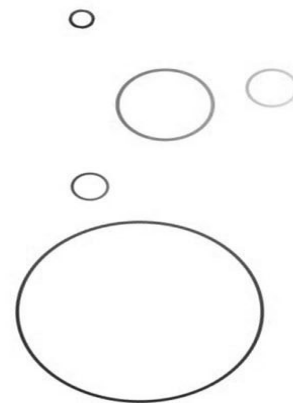
When Marley arrived in March, her curve measured 46 degrees. A scoliosis diagnosis was a lot to take in, but the Shriners Children's Texas team provided immediate support and peace of mind.

Her physician, William Phillips, M.D., explained that Marley would begin bracing to help guide her spine into a healthier position. "Dr. Phillips is nice and very informative about his work. He answered all my questions," Marley said. Her mom, Dana, felt relief, too. "We were thankful when Dr. Phillips said the brace is going to fix it, and she will not need surgery."

Marley soon met with the Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS) team to be fitted for her brace. The clinicians customized it to her measurements and made small adjustments as she tested it out. She practiced taking it on and off, and spent time sitting in it to learn how the brace would feel during her day. Marley's POPS clinician went over the wear schedule with her, which helped her feel prepared when she returned home.

Throughout the process, Dana watched her daughter approach each step with determination. "She is so tough. It does not matter what challenge arises. She has such a positive attitude about everything, and I think that makes a huge difference in how we tackle new challenges."

Marley will return to Shriners Children's Texas every three months for follow-up care and will wear her brace for about two years. In the meantime, she continues to participate in all her extracurricular activities. She plans to stay busy as an older sister and has big dreams to become a litigator. "I want to be a lawyer, but I want to be like one of those big lawyers that deal with crime," she said with a grin.

Marley grows closer each day to correcting her scoliosis and continues to show those around her what strength looks like. When she returns for follow-up care, she is always looking forward to hanging out at the beach or exploring the many activities Galveston Island offers.

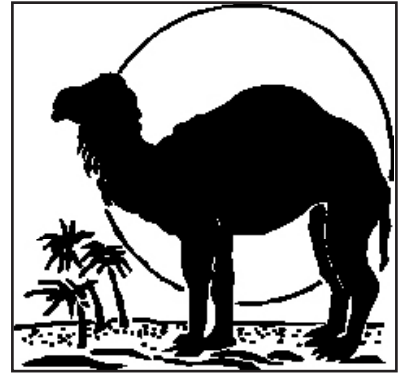
